Our Honorees

The Sea Cliff - Glen Head Lions Club is proud to present the Fall Classic XVII. Created in 2000 by Edward L. Lieberman, Esq. and Rickey Borer, the Fall Classic has developed into a major annual fund-raising event benefiting many local charities and causes.

Karen and Nick Montagnese have lived in Sea Cliff for over 30 years. Nick is President of a local small business that has served and supported the community for more than 60 years. Karen has a Masters in Social Work and has worked for the Village of Sea Cliff as their Senior Citizen Outreach Worker for over 6 years. She helps and advocates for our seniors working closely with Mutual Concerns and the Senior Action Committees. Recently Karen and Nick volunteered to spearhead the publishing of the Sea Cliff Village Bulletin. Karen is the Managing Editor and Nick is on the Editorial Staff. Nick also volunteers on the Sea Cliff Technology Task Force. Their three daughters attended North Shore High School.

Most notably Karen and Nick work tirelessly in the fight to cure blindness. They are founding officers of the Long Island Chapter of the Foundation Fighting Blindness (FFB), Co-Chairs of its annual VisionWalk and National Trustees of the Foundation. There are 10 million people in the U.S. affected by retinal degenerative diseases and millions more worldwide. This is a cause very dear to them as Karen has lost her sight to Retinitis Pigmentosa (RP), one of the many diseases that the Foundation aims to cure. Currently there are 20 human clinical trials underway or ready to launch and past trials have lead to the FDA approval of the "bionic retina" as well as two drugs that treat wet Macular Degeneration. Karen and Nick's work has raised awareness and funds to promote this sight saving research around the globe. Their VisionWalk team, "Karen's Friends" has walked in rain and shine raising \$200,000.00 over the past 11 years. This is their contribution to the over 700 million dollars raised since the Foundation's inception in 1971.

It is this dedicated and devoted service to our community and those in need that the Sea Cliff-Glen Head Lions Club proudly proclaims Karen and Nick Montagnese as our honorees of the Fall Classic XVII.
